

An ERASMUS BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAM – An Exciting Course – A Student Film Festival – Screenings Gigs and Surprise Events at ESZTERHÁZY KÁROLY CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY Eger, Hungary - 15-19 +1 extra day (optional) May, 2023

April 17, Monday – **first online session** with participants at 10am – Zoom link is going to be sent a few days before for all participants (ERAM, Sapientia, UNATC, Eszterházy). Theme of the session: Introduction to the course. Ways of searching for archive material (analogue or digital). For the selection of materials, online session could be repeated before the course (tbd).

May 14, Sunday — **arrival to Eger** — For those coming via Budapest, suggested arrival to Budapest during daytime, arrival to Eger in the evening. Trains from Budapest to Eger go every hour from Keleti Pu. until 7pm. (Later than that there are buses, in case). Eastern Railway Station is easy to reach by Metro line2 or Metro line4.

May 15, Monday – **first session** 10am to 4pm – Introduction of the participants and the tutors. Screening samples and short movies that apply archive, historical or home made footage. Selection of the photos and footage that the participants bring with themselves. Deciding about the genre. Editing works. (Possible genres are animation, short doc, diary,

film essay, experimental). Venues: University building 'A', Institute Kepes. 7pm: Screening a recent audience favourite Hungarian movie, Cinema Urania.

May 16, Tuesday – **second session** 10am to 4pm – Development of the projects. Venues: University building 'A', Institute Kepes. 7pm: Opening of Slow Film Festival, a yearly international meeting of film students and competition program. 7.30pm: Screening a recent audience favourite movie from world cinema, Cinema Urania. 9pm: Live Concert and Party.

May 17, Wednesday – **third session** 10am to 4pm - Development of the projects. Venues: University building 'A', Institute Kepes. 3pm: Out of Competition Block I. 5pm: Competition Block I., 7pm: Competition Block II. Cinema Urania. A surprise late evening program planned after the screenings.

May 18, Thursday – **fourth session** 10am to 4pm – Development and sound works of the projects. Venues: University building 'A', Institute Kepes. 3pm: Out of Competition Block II., 5pm: Competition Block IV. 9pm: Live Concert, Cinema Urania.

May 19, Friday – **fifth session** 10am to 4pm - Finalizing the projects (sound works, mixing, coloring). 5pm: Screening the shorts made during the Course. 7pm: Prize Winning Ceremony. 8pm: Closing and Party, Cinema Urania.

May 20, Saturday – a day in Budapest – This program may be depending on the travelling route. In case the participants travel by air - and via Budapest - an extra day and night can be spent in the Capital City with a course related professional program.
